

MINUTES  
February 7, 2017

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, February 7, 2017 at the Borough Building, 239 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

Present were Councilpersons Rogers, A'zary, Wickham, VonBlohn, Richardson, Herritt and Rodman. Also present were S. Berkey, B. Brady, J. Hart, J. Shrawder, J. Hack, Fire Chief Moyer, B. Horne, E. Gill and Solicitor Dennehey. Absent was W. Walters, Mayor Swank and Junior Council Ciucci.

The invocation was given by Rick Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Prior to the regular meeting, Council met in executive session to discuss pending sewer litigation.

**Topics**

1. One bid was received for a Street Department pick-up truck for a Ford F250, 4x4 super duty from Spangler Motors for \$25, 889. Budget amount was \$30,000. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. VonBlohn and a unanimous vote, Council approved this bid.
2. The Fire Department updated their internal constitution and by-laws recently. The Borough code needs to reflect the change extending the service of the Fire Chief from two to four years. An Ordinance needs adopted to make the change. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council approved advertising this Ordinance for adoption next month.
3. Motion by Mr. VonBlohn, seconded by Mr. Rogers and a unanimous vote, Council approved the request from PA One Call System to recognize the month of April as "PA 811 Safe Digging Month". A proclamation will be signed.
4. Betty Ann Moyer has volunteered as the voting delegate for the 2017 PSAB conference. Motion by Mr. VonBlohn, seconded by Mr. Rogers, and a unanimous vote, Council approved.
5. Reallocation of \$176,850 in Capital Reserve from Upper Mulberry St. culvert project to rehabilitation work on the Montour Street Bridge. It has been determined that the Upper Mulberry Street culvert project is CDBG eligible. Motion was made by Rogers, seconded by Wickham with Mr. A'zary opposing, the reallocation was approved by a majority vote.
6. Approval is required for a subdivision for 11 Water Street and 2 Cross Keys. The project has prior approval from the Zoning Hearing Board, Danville Borough Planning and Montour County Planning. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Rogers and a unanimous vote, Council approved this subdivision.

7. The Mayor and Chief would like to have the Department & Economic Development do a Management Review of the Borough's Police Department. Last time this was reviewed was in April 2000. Motion by Mr. A'Zary, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council approved this letter of intent.
