June 6, 2017

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, June 6, 2017 at the Borough Building, 239 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

Present were Councilpersons Richardson, Rogers, A'zary, VonBlohn, Herritt, Rodman, Wickham, Walters and Mayor Swank. Also present were S. Berkey, J. Shrawder, B. Horne, B. Brady, J. Hart, J. Hack, Fire Chief Moyer, J. Graham, E. Gill and Solicitor Marks Sr.

The invocation was given by Rick Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

1. Ordinance No. 544, to amend Chapter 250, entitled "Water" , will be placed as an "action item" for the June 13th Council Meeting to approve advertising for next month.
2. A request from Matt Chappell on behalf of the Goodwill Hose Co. to close a section of streets for a block party has been withdrawn.
3. The Personnel Committee recommended to hire Cody Clossen (pending passing of all testing) at a rate of \$16.25/hr. Motion by Mr. Wickham, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, Council approved this recommendation.
4. Jacobs Landing - The Planning Commission discussed an amended application for the Jacobs Landing development. The approved plan is inclusive of two - three unit townhouses with the amended application depicting two - four unit townhouses. Motion made by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Walters and a unanimous vote, Council approved this application.
5. 215-217-219 Bloom Street - The Planning Commission reviewed an application for a subdivision to add a portion of the Borough owned railroad bed to the owners of 215-217-219 Bloom Street. The property transfer has been approved by the Street Committee as well as the Property Committee. Motion by Mr. A'Zary, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council approved the application with the conditions given by the Planning Commission.

Motion made by Mr. A'Zary, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council also approved HARB's request for a certificate of appropriateness for this property.

6. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, Council approved a certificate of appropriateness for work at 15 East Market St.

7. Memorandum of Understanding between the Continental Fire Company and the Danville Borough. Mr. Walters made the motion to approve with Mr. Wickham a second. Majority vote passed the motion with Mr. Rogers and Mr. VonBlohn opposed.
