Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, July 3, 2018 at the Borough Building, 463 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

Present were Councilpersons Richardson, Rogers, Herritt, Rodman, Stigerwalt, Walter, Woodruff, and Mayor Swank. Also present were B. Brady, B. Earlston, J. Hart, J. Shrawder, Jon Swank (Police), and Attorney Marks, Sr. Absent was W. Walters.

The invocation was given by Attorney Marks followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Action Items from 6/5/18

1. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Woodruff and a unanimous vote, Council approved the Ferry Street Growers Market MOU revision.

Topics

1. Resolution 2018-9 authorizing signatories for the First Columbia Bank & Trust loan. A motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Stigerwalt and a unanimous vote, Council approved this Resolution.
2. Letter & Resolution from PennDot authorizing upgrades to the rail crossing at Church St. It has been confirmed that gates will be installed also. Motion made by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Walter and a unanimous vote, Council approved this Resolution. A question was brought up as to whether Ferry St. will be improved soon and it will be along with the Mill St. project.
3. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Stigerwalt and a unanimous vote, Council approved the American Legion's request for use of Fire Police on Sunday, July 15th.
4. Ordinance No. 552 will be advertised and ready for adoption on July 10th, pertaining to the loan for street paving.
5. Discussion regarding the upgrades to the railroad warning system at the Mill St. intersection and the elimination of pedestrian crossing gates. Motion made by Mr. Woodruff, seconded by Mr. Walter and a unanimous vote to not install gates. It has been confirmed that there will be lights for pedestrians at this crossing.
6. A request has been made from Service 1st Credit Union for access to electricity at Riverfront Park for the annual Duck Derby to be held on Saturday, August 4, 2018. The use would be to power a food truck and a live broadcast with 94KX radio station. This item will be placed as an ACTION item for the August meeting.

FYI Items

1. Geisinger has approved funding to revitalize the North Island on Continental Blvd. between Route 11 and West Mahoning St. The project will be completed by Ettingers.
2. The Danville Area Community Center will be utilizing the tennis courts for a youth camp July 16th thru the 20th from 9 AM till noon.
