Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, July 11, 2017 at the Borough Building, 239 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

1. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. VonBlohn and a unanimous vote, Council approved the adoption of Ordinance No. 544 to amend Chapter 250, entitled "Water".
2. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. A'Zary and a unanimous vote, Council approved John Hack's request to remove a dead tree, including the stump, that sits on Borough property in the 100 block of E. Market Street.
3. Council agreed in February to contribute 1/3 of the funds for a refurbishment of the WWI monument, providing that the Borough is awarded the 100 cities/100 Memorial Grant for \$2000 and that the VFW and Legion agree to cover 1/3 of the cost. At this time, the service organizations want to move forward with this project before the weather is not agreeable even though the grant has not been awarded. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. VonBlohn and a unanimous vote, Council agreed to move forward on this project. These Grants are expected to be awarded around Veteran's Day.
4. Larson Design has provided an agreement for the scope of work to complete the engineering and design for the Upper Susquehanna Levee. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. A'Zary and a unanimous vote, Council agreed to this work and the signing of the agreement with Larson to complete FEMA accreditation.
