August 1, 2017

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, August 1, 2017 at the Borough Building, 239 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

Present were Councilpersons Richardson, Rogers, VonBlohn, Herritt, Rodman, Wickham, Walters and Mayor Swank. Also present were S. Berkey, J. Shrawder, B. Horne, B. Brady, J. Hart, J. Hack, Fire Chief Moyer, J. Graham, E. Gill and Solicitor Dennehey. Absent was E. A'Zary.

The invocation was given by Rick Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Public Comments

1. Drew Barton, from Larson Design Group spoke on the MS4 permitting process. A public meeting is required and the Borough also needs to provide the public the ability to comment for 45 days. Drew reviewed the application, its intent and the steps going forward.

1. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, Council approved Resolution No. 2017-8 as part of the "Green Light Go" application process.
2. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council approved Resolution No. 2017-9 as part of the "Keystone Communities Program" grant application.
3. Motion by Mr. VonBlohn, seconded by Mr. Rogers and a unanimous vote, Council approved the only bid for the sale of the bridge pier stones from IOLA Lumber for \$2,850.
4. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. VonBlohn and a unanimous vote, Council approved to designate September as "Childhood Cancer Awareness" month and place gold bows on the parking meters in town.
