

MINUTES

October 3, 2017

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, October 3, 2017 at the Borough Building, 239 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

Present were Councilpersons Richardson, Rogers, Herritt, Rodman, Wickham, A'Zary, Walters and Mayor Swank. Also present were S. Berkey, B. Horne, B. Brady, J. Hart, B. Earlston, Fire Chief Moyer, E. Gill and Solicitor Dennehy.

1. Motion by Mr. A'Zary, seconded by Mr. VonBlohn and a unanimous vote, Council approved the lease agreement with the Danville Municipal Authority for disposal of sewage sludge on the Borough farm.
2. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, Council gave approval of an application for the development of a stormwater plan for the partial paving of the Washies Playground parking lot on the conditions that (1) E & S Permit received from the Montour County Conservation District; and (2) O & M Agreement is made between the Washington Fire Co. and the Little League.
3. The subdivision of 235/237 Mill St. was approved by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote.
4. HARB recommended a fence construction at 215-217-219 Bloom St. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Rogers and a unanimous vote, Council approved of this construction.
5. Proposal from Larson Design Group was attached for the street light inspection and report to determine what lights need replaced. The cost is being proposed to be split three ways (Riverside/Danville/Mahoning) at a cost of \$1,433.33 for each municipality. This will be placed as an action item on the October 10th agenda.
