

# MINUTES

## November 1, 2016

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, November 1, 2016, at the Borough Building, 239 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. Vice-President Rogers presided.

Present were Councilpersons Rodman, Rogers, A'zary, Wickham, Walters, VonBlohn, Herritt and Mayor Swank. Also present were S. Berkey, E. Gill, B. Brady, J. Hack, J. Hart, J. Shrawder, B. Horne, Fire Chief Moyer and Solicitor Marks Sr. Absent was S. Richardson.

The invocation was given by Rick Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

### **Topics**

1. Ordinance No. 537 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" is ready for adoption on Nov. 8<sup>th</sup>. This will be placed as an ACTION item.
2. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, Council approved the request to advertise an Ordinance that will assist in enforcement of the Danville Municipal Authority's amended Rules & Regulations.
3. The Finance Committee will be reconvening their 5:00 meeting after the Council meeting is over to continue discussing the 2017 budget.
4. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, Council approved an application submitted by the Planning Commission to subdivide two existing adjoining properties on the corner of Spruce and Cherry Street (409-411 Spruce St.), which would result in three residential parcels. This subdivision would provide for the construction of a two-family dwelling placed on bordering lots with the capability of being sold separately.
