

MINUTES
November 7, 2017

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 at the Borough Building, 463 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

Present were Councilpersons Richardson, Rogers, Herritt, Rodman, Wickham, A'Zary, Walters, VonBlohn and Mayor Swank. Also present were S. Berkey, B. Horne, J. Hart, J. Graham, B. Earlston, Fire Chief Moyer, J. Swank, Attorney Dennehy and Solicitor Marks.

The invocation was given by Rick Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Public Comments

1. Mr. Richard Cornell attended asking for a response on his offer to purchase Borough property on Bald Top for \$10,000. Mr. Dennehy explained the ownership of the land in question is not absolute. Borough Council has agreed to sign an agreement with the Mordans to not contest over the land above or below Route 11. This will allow Cornell and the Mordans to have an issue/dispute with each other over land on the top of Bald Top.

Topics

1. Preliminary approval was made of the 2018 Budget and to advertise this Budget with a 6.5% tax increase. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Rogers and the following roll call vote, this was approved:

Mayor Swank broke the tie to approve the 2018 Budget.

2. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. A'Zary and a unanimous vote, Council approved the advertising of an ordinance to post Wall Street with 25 MPH speed limit signs.
3. Approval of the agreement with Larson Design Group for engineering on the Green Light Go traffic signal retiming grant contingent upon receipt of the fully executed grant agreement from PennDot has been tabled.
4. The Agreement to be executed with Larson Design Group for the hosting of our GIS that was done for the MS4 permit will be put as an ACTION item for the November 14th Council Meeting.
5. The 2018 recycling agreement with the Town of Bloomsburg was approved by a motion from Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. A'Zary and a 6-2 vote. Voting no were Mr. Herritt and Mr. Wickham.

6. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council approved the new agreement with the Danville Little League for use of Echo Field.
7. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Rogers and a unanimous vote, Council approved the new agreements with the Borough of Riverside for sewer pump station maintenance services and composite sampling services for 2018-2020.
