

NOTICE TO PARK & TRAIL USERS

2020 – 2021 HUNTING SEASONS IN MONTOUR COUNTY (WMU 4E)

SMALL GAME

SQUIRRELS: Sept 12 – Nov 27; Dec 14 – 24; and Dec 26 – Feb 27

RUFFED GROUSE: Oct 17 – Nov 27 and Dec 14 – 24

RABBIT (YOUTH SEASON): Oct 3 – 17

RABBIT: Oct 17 – Nov 27; Dec 14 – 24; and Dec 26 – Feb 27

PHEASANT (YOUTH SEASON): Oct 10 – 17

PHEASANT: Oct 24 – Nov 27; Dec 14 – 24; and Dec 26 – Feb 27

WOODCHUCKS (GROUNDHOGS): No closed season, except on Sundays and during the regular firearms deer seasons

LARGE GAME

TURKEY: Oct 31 – Nov 14

TURKEY (SPRING GOBBLER; YOUTH SEASON): April 24, 2021

TURKEY (SPRING GOBBLER): May 1 – 31, 2021

BLACK BEAR (ARCHERY): Oct 17 - Nov 7

BLACK BEAR (MUZZLELOADER): Oct 17 – 24

BLACK BEAR (SPECIAL FIREARMS): Oct 22 - 24

BLACK BEAR: Nov 21 – 24 (**including Sunday, Nov 22**) and Nov 30 – Dec 5

DEER (ARCHERY; ANTLERED & ANTLERLESS): Oct 3 – Nov 20 (**including Sunday, Nov 15**) and Dec 26 – Jan 18

DEER (ANTLERLESS, MUZZLELOADER): Oct 17 – 24

DEER (ANTLERLESS, SPECIAL FIREARMS): Oct 22 – 24

DEER (REGULAR FIREARMS, ANTLERED ONLY): Nov 28 – Dec 4 (**including Sunday, Nov 29**)

DEER (REGULAR FIREARMS, ANTLERED OR ANTLERLESS): Dec 5 – Dec 12

DEER (ANTLERED OR ANTLERLESS, FLINTLOCK): Dec 26 – Jan 18

Though hunting is not allowed within the boundaries of the Montour Preserve, the Hess Recreation Area, or the North Branch Canal Trail, hunting is allowed at the Hopewell Park / Danville Borough Farm Trail System (for those with special permits from Danville Borough) and does occur on adjacent private lands around all sites.

MARC encourages all park and trail visitors to always remain alert to their surroundings and wear brightly-colored clothing during hunting seasons. MARC also encourages visitors to place a brightly-colored vest on pets (where allowed) and keep pets on leash and close at hand at all times.

NOTE: The seasons listed here are those most commonly of interest to park and trail users, but this is not an all-inclusive listing of hunting and trapping seasons in Montour County.
