Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, February 6, 2018 at the Borough Building, 463 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Richardson presided.

Present were Councilpersons Richardson, Rogers, Herritt, Rodman, Walters, Woodruff, Walter and Mayor Swank. Absent was Stigerwalt. Also present were S. Berkey, B. Brady, B. Horne, J. Hart, B. Earlston, J. Shrawder, Fire Chief Moyer, Chief Gill and Attorney Marks.

The invocation was given by Rick Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

1. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Rogers and a unanimous vote, Council approved the Danville Riverside Ministerium Association (DRAMA) Cross Walk to be held on Good Friday, March 30, 2018 from approximately 10 AM till noon.
2. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Woodruff and a unanimous vote, Council agreed to sign a proclamation to designate April as "Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month" as requested by Pennsylvania One Call System.
3. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, Council agreed to the engagement letter from Siana Bellwoar, Attorneys at Law for their supplemental legal services to the Borough.
4. PennDot would like to organize a Community Advisory Committee pertaining to the PA 54 and PA 642 corridor project. Mr. Woodruff has expressed interest in being the Borough's representative. Motion by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council gave approval for Mr. Woodruff to represent the Borough on this committee.
5. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Walter and a unanimous vote, Council approved Dr. Dan Rogers as the MARC representative for the Danville Borough.
6. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Woodruff and a unanimous vote, Council gave approval to an agreement Pursuant to Act 139 of 2014 & DOh-001-2018 Standing Order between the Office of the Montour County Coroner and the Danville Police Department which permits the Danville Police Department to obtain and use a supply of naloxone in an emergency along with a corresponding Danville Police Department Policy.
7. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Herritt and a unanimous vote, Council approved reallocating CDBG funds from the Mill Street Streetscape project to the

Washies complex parking project. The low bid for the parking lot project came in approximately \$5,200 more than the already allocated funding.
