

Danville Borough Council Meeting
Minutes
March 3, 2020

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 at the Borough Building, 463 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. Vice-President Woodruff presided.

Present were Councilpersons, Walters, Woodruff, Herritt, Walter, Beers, Gregg and Rodman. Also present were Mayor Swank, J. Hart, J. Swank, B. Brady, S. Berkey, B. Horne, B. Earliston and Fire Chief Buckenburger. Absent was K. Herritt and J. Stigerwalt.

The invocation was given by Mr. Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Before the start of the meeting, Vice-President Woodruff informed the public that an executive session was held prior to the start of this meeting to discuss personnel hiring and the police union contract. A session of Council was also held on Tuesday, February 25th to discuss personnel issues.

Topics

1. A request to place a stop sign at the intersection of the alleys traveling North from Bloom St. to Center St. between Ash St. and Vine St. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Gregg and a unanimous vote, Council approved this request.
2. Dumpster Day will take place on Saturday, April 25th.
3. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Walters and a unanimous vote, Council approved the adoption of Resolution No. 2020-2, Danville Borough Emergency Action Plan.
4. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Walter and a unanimous vote, Council approved the following HARB applications:
 - a) **569 Mill** - The Board discussed an application for the replacement of all windows on the rear of the building.
 - ◆ Seven windows would be replaced "in kind"
 - ◆ One window would be replaced with a shorter double hung window. This window is located in a bathroom which would provide an area to place a vanity.
 - ◆ One window located in the kitchen will be replaced with an awning style window.
 - ◆ Also permission to remove a non-functional chimney was part of the request.

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- b) **255 Church St.**- The Board discussed an application for the replacement of the door located on the East side of the building. The proposed door will be similar to the door replaced on the North side of the building in a recent remodel.
 - c) **135 West Market** - The Board discussed an application for the replacement of a fence, the proposed fence will be black aluminum to mimic a wrought iron look.
 - d) **64 Bloom** - The Board reviewed an application for the demolition of the deteriorated porch located on the East side of the structure.
5. Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Walter and a unanimous vote, Council approved the following applications for the Planning Commission:
- a) **601 E. Market St.** (GTI) – a land development plan which will alter the truck maneuvering easement as well as establish a 23 space parking area for the MBC tenant. The plan was approved by the Commission upon the endorsed:
 - ◆ First Amendment to cross easement declaration and maintenance agreement.
 - ◆ Parking Area Maintenance Agreement and Declaration.
 - b) **342 Green St.** – Subdividing a parcel located at 324 Green St. The subdivision resulted in two building lots.
 - c) **Foust St.** – Subdivision of a vacant lot for the development of two buildings lots. A two family dwelling will be constructed on each lot.


