

**Danville Borough Council Meeting
Minutes
December 3, 2019**

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, December 3, 2019 at the Borough Building, 463 Mill St., Danville at 6:00 PM. President Herritt presided.

Present were Councilpersons, Walters, Rodman, Woodruff, Herritt, Walter, Beers, Gregg and Stigerwalt. Also present were Mayor Swank, J. Hart, B. Earlston, J. Swank, B. Brady, B. Mordan and J. Graham.

The invocation was given by Rich Vreeland followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Topics

Note – Comments and/or questions on each topic will be addressed before a Council member moves for Action.

1. Ordinance No. 560 will be advertised and ready for adoption on December 10th. “Vehicles and Traffic” – restricting section of Cherry St. to truck traffic. On a motion by Mr. Rodman, this Ordinance will be placed as an ACTION item for the December 10th meeting.
2. Ordinance No. 561 will be advertised and ready for adoption on December 10th. Tax Ordinance for 2020 implementing interim taxes and including a 1% tax increase. Motion by Mr. Rodman, this item will be placed as an ACTION item for the December 10th meeting.
3. PSAB is suggesting that Council sign a Resolution in support of HB 1775 & SB 101 – Stormwater Facilities on State Highways. Motion by Mr. Rodman, seconded by Mr. Walters and a unanimous vote, Council supported this Resolution.
4. The Planning Commission is recommending the following:
 - a) County Offices at 435 E. Front St.
 - Approval of SALDO
 - Approval of advertising an Ordinance to change Friendship alley from one-way West to East to one-way East to West
 - Approval to utilize section 237.4 to place signs 90 days prior to Ordinance adoption

Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Woodruff and a unanimous vote, Council approved this recommendation. Mr. Stigerwalt abstained as a County employee.

- b) Maintenance Garage 733 Ironmen Lane
 - Verification of utilities letter
 - Containment box for stored fuel

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Motion by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Stigerwalt and a unanimous vote, the schedule was approved as proposed.

1. Letter from FEMA requesting the Borough to submit a Levee Strategy and Implementation Plan for the levee systems comprising the Danville Flood Protection system. Council has already contracted with Wood, PLC to facilitate this submission.
2. Letter from the Municipal Authority requesting that Mr. Peter Rickert be appointed to serve an additional 5-year term on the Danville Municipal Authority. Motion by Mr. Stigerwalt, seconded by Mr. Rodman and a unanimous vote, the appointment was approved.
3. Boot Camp Registration - President Herritt expressed the importance of this educational session and highly recommended that new Council members consider attending. President Herritt also informed Council that the expense of the session is covered by the Borough.
4. Careerlink will be setting up in front of the Municipal Building on Wednesday, December 18th from 10AM till 3PM.
