

**DANVILLE BOROUGH COUNCIL  
RESOLUTION NO. - 2021-04**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No.537, known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires Danville Borough (referred to sometimes herein as a municipality) to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Gannett Fleming, Inc., has prepared a report to the Danville Municipal Authority (DMA) entitled "Special Study Under Act 537 for Fisher Court Pump Station, Franklin Street Sewer & WWTP Dewatering Improvements " (hereinafter "Plan"), which provides for facilities to treat sewage generated in Danville Borough; and

WHEREAS, the alternatives of choice to be implemented by the municipality and DMA, as described in the Pennsylvania Special Study Under Act 537 For Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project, includes the following:

- Replace the Fisher Court Pump Station and force main.
- Replace the Franklin Street sewer.
- Replace the Belt Filter Press with two new centrifuges including new polymer feed systems, biosolids conveyance systems and ancillary equipment.
- Replace the existing Greenhouse with a new CMU building to house the dewatering system as well as provide enclosed areas for equipment and truck storage.

WHEREAS, DMA plans to fund the WWTP Improvements Project through a combination of DMA Cash and Cash Investments and a PENNVEST loan.

WHEREAS, DMA plans to bid the construction contract and award a construction contract in 2021 and complete the construction of the improvements through 2022 and early 2023; and


WHEREAS, Danville Borough finds that the Plan conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of Danville Borough hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the Official Sewage Facilities Plan of the municipality, the above-referenced Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said Plan, as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).


