

**SCHEDULE A  
WATER RATES AND CHARGES  
DANVILLE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY**

A ten percent (10%) penalty will be added to all bills not paid within 1) thirty (30) calendar days for monthly and quarterly bills; and 2) for all other bills (i.e., annual fire protection bills) will be due 12/31/XXXX. These grace periods will be calculated from date of the bill.

**A. SCHEDULE OF FLAT RATES**

All property owners serviced with an unmetered water service by the Authority shall pay water rates in accordance with the following schedule. Each class of service shall pay the basic rate indicated for the particular class.

**1. Base Charge:**

<u>Class of Service</u>	<u>Quarterly Charge</u>
(a) Single family residence (includes condominiums, townhouses, mobile homes, apartments (each unit) and trailers)	\$ 114.00

**2. Special Charges:**

(a) Public and Private Fire Hydrant Rates -- Annual	
(1) Public inside Borough	No Charge
(2) Public outside the Borough, each	\$ 672.80
(3) Private, each	\$ 672.80

The annual charge shall apply to each fire hydrant connected ahead of a meter and to each fire hydrant connected after a meter that is not of adequate size for fire flow service.

(b) Essential Community Services Group	\$6.16 per 1,000 gallons
(c) Room Charge (per premises)	Meter Size Customer Charge

(b) Private Fire Protection

Special Provisions

Water delivered through fire services shall be used for fire purposes only. Water used through a fire service for other purposes shall be billed in accordance with the metered rates and shall be in addition to the annual standby service charge.

(c) Temporary Water Service

(1) A minimum Twenty-Five Dollar (\$25.00) deposit will be required with the submission of each application for permit for temporary use of water. All costs of installing and dismantling or disconnecting Authority service connections (including the meter when required by the Authority) shall be paid for by the Applicant. The minimum fee for the installation and dismantling or disconnecting the service shall be Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00). If the Authority elects to install a meter, the water consumed shall be paid for in accordance with the Schedule of Metered Rates. The charge for non-metered water consumed shall be made in accordance with Section V, Paragraph F, Article 6 of the Rules and Regulations.

(2) Water Use through a Hydrant (e.g., demolition work):

Usage Fee	\$250.00
Consumption Charge	Current metered rate per 1,000 gallon units
Security Deposit	\$500.00

(e) Installing and Dismantling Service Connections

All costs for installing and dismantling Authority service connections shall be paid by the Applicant. The minimum fee shall be \$25.00.

(f) Discontinuance of Service Fee

An administrative fee of \$15.00 shall be charged for discontinuance notification and procedures.

(g) Restoration Fee

When water service has been discontinued by the Authority for non-payment of rents or for any other reasons in accordance with these Rules and Regulations, a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) service charge, payable in advance, shall be made for restoration of water service that occurs during normal weekday business hours (8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.). If restoration is requested outside normal weekday business hours, the fee shall be One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.00).

(h) Change of Ownership (Metered Account)

A charge of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) will be billed to the new Owner/Occupant to cover meter reading and administration costs related to the change in ownership or occupant of a property.

(i) Shut-off and Turn-on Charge at Curb Box

There will be no charge for temporary shut-off or turn-on of water service to a premise if requested and performed during the Authority's normal weekday business hours (8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.). A One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollar (\$125.00) charge, payable in advance, unless an emergency exists, shall be made for turning water on or off when the service is performed outside of regularly scheduled work hours, on weekends, or on holidays.

(j) Bad Checks

A charge of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$40.00) will be made for each Customer's check that is returned to the Authority from a bank due to insufficient funds.

(k) Determination of Estimated Fire Service Capability (See Form, Appendix F)

(1) Engineer's estimated fire flow – \$600.00

(2) Hydrant flow testing and engineer's review – \$1,500.00

B. SCHEDULE OF METERED RATES

Metered Customers shall be subject to the following charges. Each Customer shall pay either the Consumption Charge or the Minimum Charge, whichever charge is greater.

1. Consumption Charge:

3. Required Minimum Meter Test Deposits:

For any 3-inch meter	\$ 500.00
For any 4-inch meter	\$ 500.00
For any 6-inch meter	\$ 500.00

4. Standby Service:

Normal metered rates, including Consumption Charges and Minimum Charges, shall apply to standby service.

5. Metered Service Special Charges:

(a) Commercial Water Haulers:

Water shall be sold only to commercial water haulers who have secured and retain Authority approval. Commercial water haulers shall be billed quarterly or monthly as determined by the Authority for their total metered water consumption on the basis of the Metered Consumption Charge Schedule plus a per load charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). If supplied with water from an unmetered source, the volume of water consumed shall be computed based on the volume of the carrier and the number of fillings and the consumption charge calculated in accordance with the Metered Consumption Charge Schedule. The decision to make water sales during drought conditions is up to the discretion of the Water Superintendent.

(b) Where more than one Consumer Unit is located in one building, house, or other structure owned by one Consumer and such building, house or other structure, at the discretion of the Authority, is served by one service connection, multiple charges per quarter shall be computed by applying Schedule A, Water Rates and Charges, to each Consumer Unit so served.

(c) Emergency or temporary water service that may be furnished by the Authority shall be at such rate or charge as shall be determined by resolution of the Board of the Authority in each individual case.
